### **APP WRITTEN EXAMINATION DATE (TENTATIVE) ANNOUNCED** **14TH DECEMBER 2025**

In the ongoing Recruitment Process of Assistant Public Prosecutors, receipt of Online Applications has been closed on 11<sup>th</sup> October 2025 and at the end of the Application-Filing Procedure, 3,132 Applications (before scrutiny) were preliminarily received. Of these, 1,908 pertain to Men Candidates and 1,224 are of Women Candidates. From the data provided by the Candidates online, it could be inferred that 18% of the Candidates belong to OC Category, 47% to BC Category, 26% to SC Category and 9% to ST Category.

All the Candidates are informed herewith that the Written Examination comprising of 2 Papers will be tentatively conducted on 14<sup>th</sup> December 2025 (Sunday) with the following schedule –
