CANDIDATES SHORTLISTED FOR WRITTEN EXAMS - ANNOUNCED

In the process of Certificates Verification conducted during 20th-31st January 2026, as a part of the ongoing direct recruitment in Telangana Forensic Science Laboratory, 3,760 Candidates out of 4,664 attended and got their Certificates verified. Further, the Board conducted a rigorous procedure of data-verification and purification of the information obtained in the Certificates Verification as per the relevant Rules and Regulations.

As per the procedure mentioned in the Notification (*Please refer to para 12*), Candidates have been shortlisted to attend the Written Examinations in the ratio of 1:5 (i.e. 5 Shortlisted Candidates for each Post notified) covering all horizontal and vertical category reservations based on the merit of their weightage marks. **Details of the Shortlisted Candidates for Written Exams and Cut-off marks – each Post-wise, are made available on our website (www.tgprb.in).**

SEEKING OF CLARIFICATIONS BY CANDIDATES ON NON-QUALIFICATION

Candidates are now being provided an opportunity online on the TSLPRB website (www.tgprb.in) to seek clarification/s required, if any, only on matters pertinent to the Qualification for Written Examinations, in the Web Template (shown below) which will be made available to them in their respective login areas **from 8 a m on 18th February 2026 to 8 a m on 21st February 2026**, by making a payment of Rs.500/- per clarification for each Post (chosen for clarification) through our payment gateway.

WRITTEN EXAMS SCHEDULED FROM 5th TO 7th MARCH 2026

It was earlier informed to all the Candidates in our Press Note dated 21st December 2025 that Candidates shortlisted as per the procedure given in the Notification shall be required to appear for Written Examinations tentatively during the 3rd/ 4th week of February 2026 in Hyderabad. Now further details in this regard are as follows – The Written Examinations to the shortlisted Candidates for the respective Posts will be held at the Venue of **Police Training Centre, Medchal, Hyderabad** on 5th, 6th and 7th March 2026.

Duration of each Technical Paper – Written Examination will be 1 hour and the Candidates will not be allowed to leave in between. Written Exams will comprise of 10 (ten) Questions seeking the Candidates to give short descriptive answers in approximately 100 words for each Question. Answering of all 10 (ten) Questions is compulsory. Written Examinations will be preliminarily evaluated for a total of 100 marks (@ 10 marks per each Question) and the marks obtained in the Written Exam will be scaled as per the weightage given in the Notification to calculate the overall Merit.
