ISSUING OF HALL TICKETS FOR FSL WRITTEN EXAMINATIONS SCHEDULED ON 5TH, 6TH & 7TH MARCH, 2026

Written Examinations in the FSL Direct Recruitment for which Notification was issued on 14th November, 2025, will be held in three sessions every day on 5th, 6th and 7th March, 2026 at Police Training College, Medchal, Hyderabad, as announced earlier through our Press Note on 18th February 2026 further to the information already provided on 21st December 2025.

Candidates who have been shortlisted for Written Examinations as per 1:5 ratio can download their Hall Tickets for the Written Examination from **8 a m on 26th February, 2026 onwards till 12 midnight on 4th March, 2026** by logging into their respective accounts on the TSLPRB website: www.tgprb.in. Candidates whose Hall Tickets could not be downloaded may send e-mail to support@tslprb.in or contact us on 9391005006 between 10.30 a m and 5.30 p m during the working days.

After downloading the Hall Tickets, Candidates **shall take a printout of the same preferably on an A4 size paper on both the sides** (so that the Hall Ticket is available on a single sheet of paper). Though it is not mandatory to take the printout in colour, **printout taken in colour nevertheless provides better visibility** when compared to monochrome (black and white) printout. No physical Hall Tickets will be sent individually to the Candidates by the Board, by post / courier. Once the printout is taken, **Candidates have to affix (with gum / adhesive - do not use staples or pins) their passport photograph (whose digital copy was earlier uploaded along with their Online Application)** at the designated place provided in the left-bottom area of the first page of the Hall Ticket, without fail. *Hall Ticket without the passport photograph affixed in the aforesaid manner will not be accepted on the day of Examination and admission to examination shall be denied to such Candidates who come to the Examination Centres without proper Hall Tickets.* Examination Schedule is reiterated below for the benefit of the Candidates –

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES

Candidates shall go through all the Instructions given on the reverse (other side) of the Hall Ticket carefully, in their own interest and comply with them scrupulously. Contents of certain important Instructions are reproduced below, for the benefit of the Candidates –

Candidate's passport photograph has to be fastened at the designated place provided in the Hall Ticket. Otherwise, Hall Ticket will not be accepted and Admission to Examination will be denied.

Candidates are advised to visit their Centre of Examination one day prior to the actual Date of Examination and make sure about the exact location of their Examination Centre. No travelling expenses will be paid for the journey, if any performed, to take the Test.

Candidates will be permitted into the Examination Hall **30 minutes prior** to the commencement of the Examination. Candidates will not be allowed into the Examination Hall, once the examination commences and will not be allowed to leave till the conclusion of the Examination. **Candidates will not be allowed into the Examination Hall, if they are late even by a minute.**

Candidates appearing for more than one Post shall use the same Hall Ticket for all the Examinations. Candidate with new downloaded Hall Ticket will not be admitted.

Candidates will be subjected to frisking to ensure that they are not carrying any electronic or other gadgets including Mobile / Cellular Phones, Tablets, Pen Drives, Bluetooth Devices, **Wrist-Watches**, Watch Calculators, Log Tables, Wallets, Purses, Notes, Charts, loose sheets or recording instruments strapped to the body or in the pockets. Candidates, particularly women are advised not to come for the examination wearing Jewelry or carrying Handbags / *Jholas* / Pouches etc. **No Cloak Room / Storage Facility to safeguard any valuables or belongings of the Candidates is available at the Examination Centre**

Candidates shall carry only (i) **Black / Blue Ball Point Pens** and (ii) **Hall Ticket (with Passport Photo)** into the Examination Hall. **Use Black / Blue Ball Point Pen to answer the questions neatly and legibly. Pens of any other colors are prohibited.** Do not use Pencil or Ink / Gel Pens.

Candidates have to answer the questions in English language only. The Written Examination comprises of 10 (ten) descriptive Questions seeking the Candidates to give short descriptive answers in approximately 100 words for each Question. **Answering all 10 (ten) Questions is compulsory.**

Candidates are informed that the Candidate specific Answer Booklet will be provided in the Examination Hall. **No additional papers will be provided. Loose sheets or papers will NOT be allowed into the Examination Hall and No paper must be detached from the Answer Booklet.**

Candidates are informed that both pre-printed Answer Booklet and Question Paper are separately provided. Each Answer Booklet consists of 24 Pages. **Candidate should write the descriptive Answers for the questions in the designated space provided for each question and in the allotted pages only in a concise manner covering salient points in the Answer Booklet.**

During the Examination, the Candidate is required to affix his / her signature on the Hall Ticket in the presence of the Invigilator which will be countersigned by the Invigilator as well as in the Nominal Roll. Candidates shall be enrolled with Biometric (fingerprint and Photo) through the Biometric Invigilator in the Examination Hall. Therefore, *Candidates are advised not to have mehendi, temporary tattoos or any obstructive material-covers on their fingers which may hamper the recording of Biometrics.* It would be the individual responsibility of each Candidate to ensure that he / she complies scrupulously with these instructions concerning Biometrics and Signature, failing which the Candidature will automatically lapse.

Candidates shall read all the instructions printed on the Answer Booklet carefully before answering the questions and abide by the Instructions, meticulously. Candidates should also ensure that, the Answer Booklet provided to him / her contains preprinted Hall Ticket Number, Photograph, Name, etc.

Adoption of any kind of unfair means or any act of impersonation during the Examination will render the Candidate(s) liable for invalidation of his / her Answer Booklet. Further he / she will forfeit the claim of appearing in the tests besides being liable for criminal action. Any infringement of the above instructions shall entail disciplinary action against the Candidate(s) which may include ban from appearing in all future Examinations of TSLPRB and other Public Service Commissions in India.

Hall Ticket must be preserved by the Candidate till the final conclusion of the process of Recruitment.
