POLICE RECRUITMENT-2026: APPLICATION SUBMISSION DATE EXTENDED LAST DATE IS 16TH SEPTEMBER, WEDNESDAY

Telangana State Level Police Recruitment Board had issued 4 Notifications on 29th July 2026 for Direct Recruitment of **7,437** vacancies to various Posts in Police; Special Protection Force; Fire, Disaster Response, Emergency & Civil Defence and Prisons & Correctional Services Departments - aggregating to **275** Vacancies of SCT SI Civil and / or equivalent, **23** Vacancies of SCT ASI, Finger Print Bureau, **7,112** Vacancies of SCT PC Civil and / or equivalent and **27** Vacancies of SCT Police Constable, Mechanic / Driver. Applications are being accepted from the Candidates through ONLINE mode in the prescribed proforma that has been made available on Website (www.tgprb.in) since 8 a m on 19th August 2026 for Direct Recruitment to the Notified Posts.

It would be pertinent to mention here the details of Pay & Perks to which the Selected Candidates are eligible for on their appointment / completion of stipendiary period of training –

Besides, there are several perquisites including Medical Treatment to the Employee and Dependent Family Members, Welfare Loans for House Building / Education of Children / Marriages of Children, Risk Allowances (up to 50-60% of Salary in High-Risk Units), Compensations for Job Related Injury / Damage, to which the Employees of Telangana State Government are entitled to.

At present, of the **3,38,336** Registered Candidates (*including Women Candidates who are almost 25% or 1/4th of the total Candidates*), **2,88,530** have proceeded forward after paying the fee and of these **2,76,085** have submitted their Online Applications. These **2,76,085** Candidates have applied for **3,80,762** different Candidatures. Aadhaar Verification taken up for the first time ever has already been completed for more than **95%** of the Candidates.

For the first time ever, Women have been provided 1/3rd or 33.3% reservation in all the Posts notified for the Special Protection Force and the Fire Services Department. Further, implementation of Group I, Group II and Group III reservations among SC Candidates is being done for the first time in Police Recruitment, during this process. Additionally, offline Aadhaar verification has also come into force in the 2026 Recruitment process.

In view of the ongoing activity of filing Online Applications, the Chairman, Telangana State Level Police Recruitment Board has recently participated in Live Programmes of Interview-cum-Phone-in Interaction with the Candidates through T-SAT on 3rd September 2026 and All India Radio on 7th September 2026. During the Programmes, the Chairman has clarified several doubts raised by the Candidates while noting their various concerns.

In the circumstances aforementioned, with an intention to facilitate the Candidates to have the opportunity to file their Online Applications conveniently it has been decided to extend the last date of receipt of Applications till 5 p m on 16th September 2026, Wednesday. All the aspiring Candidates – *especially those who are Registered / who have paid Fee and are yet to complete and submit their Online Applications* are advised to submit their Online Applications as early as possible because if they wait till the last day / last minute to submit the Online Application they are most likely to face queuing congestion, delayed online response and failed submission of Applications.
