PRELIMINARY KEYS OF TST & MST WRITTEN EXAMS RELEASED

Preliminary Keys for the Written Examinations of Traffic Supervisor Trainee (TST) and Mechanical Supervisor Trainee (MST) conducted in the Forenoon and Afternoon on 29th March, 2026 will be made available on the official website: www.tgprb.in, (please visit our Homepage) from 5 pm on 4th April 2026 onwards.

Candidates may submit Objections, if any, on Preliminary Keys for each question of the respective Paper individually along with supporting document/s, in the Web Template (shown aside) made available to them in their respective login areas, latest by 5 pm on 7th April 2026, by making payment of Rs.500/- per each Objection through payment gateway. If any Objection raised by any Candidate is found correct, the amount paid towards such Objection will be refunded. It is once again cautioned that every individual Objection of the respective Paper has to be submitted separately, by mentioning the details in the given Web Template.
